However, medical college/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- The Medical Colleges/ Institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding IV. payment of stipend during the Internship of the UG students similar to UG sections of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
- The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the ٧. Letter of Intent/Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentative of facts or fraud.
- It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regards issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be constructed that the admission in the college were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed in accordance with law against the college.
- Action to grant formal permission of the Medical assessment & Rating Board (MARB) for increased intake/starting of the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above.
